

3. Family Service of Delaware County - Mrs. Maria Shelmire - 1-28-57. Lukewarm; Felt we'd do better to spend money on pushing legislation; had long and close contact with Dr. Whitney from Elwyn on this problem.
4. Family Service of Philadelphia - Mr. Ralph Ormsby - 1-30-57; Lukewarm but willing to cooperate by informing his district secretaries of this resource.
5. Pa. Assn. For Retarded Children - Mr. Harry Blank - 2-7-57; Very brief as Mr. B. was so late; he agreed to take up matter with his board and see what could be worked out with his board - was to call back - hasn't.
6. Bryn Mawr Hospital Social Service Dept. - Mrs. Mary Keller - 2-5-57; very favorable; most liberal hospital policies seemed to be here and excellent working relationship with clinic registrar.
7. Hahnemann Hospital Social Service - Mrs. Edith Boone - 2-19-57; quite favorable; a little more freedom than usual from medical staff but large group of Catholic MD's and some question about whether they would make many referrals.
8. Community Nursing Service of Delaware County - Mrs. Elizabeth A. Groff - 2-26-57; Fairly responsive; thought nurses would be more inclined to refer directly to Family Service or hospital clinic.
9. Delaware County Hospital SSD - Miss Eleanor Ocheltree - 2-12-57; quite favorable personally but ster. done at hospital only on clearcut medical grounds; might possibly refer those who want it for other reasons.
10. Lankenau Hospital SSD - Sister Anna Cressman - 2-14-57; fairly responsive; only medical grounds here - slim possibility of referral to HBAA
11. Woman's Hospital SSD - Mrs. Webb - 2-19-57; Lukewarm but personally sympathetic to sterilization - seems entirely ruled by administrative thinking and could give no decision until speaking with director of hospital.
12. Jefferson Hospital SSD - Miss Judkins (Mary) - 2-25-57; Personally very enthusiastic and thought there would be possibility for occasional referral as operations done there only on medical grounds.
13. Penna. Prison Society - Mr. Richard Bacon - 3-4-57; Personally most enthusiastic and helpful with information about the prison set-ups. Wanted to investigate with his staff possibility of referral.

14. Mental Health Assn. of Southeastern Penna. - Mr. Richard Hunter - saw him not as a direct referral source but for information about the mental hospitals and clinics. He was most helpful and cooperative and personally favorable.

16. Hospital of the Woman's Medical College SSD - 3-11-57; Miss Olga Tattersfield. Personally very favorable - has difficulty with medical and psychiatric staff getting operations for other than medical reasons. Will discuss referral with the board.
17. Penna. Hospital SSD - Mrs. Frances Savin - 3-18-57; Personally most sympathetic but takes a dim view regarding referral - director of OPD is Catholic and medical chief of OBS quite strict re sterilization other than physical reasons.
