
Dear Miss Mayers:

Our letter of May 7, 1957 which puzzled you was prompted by an interest in learning as much as possible about resources available for individuals interested in sterilization.

We work closely, of course, with our State Eugenics Board, but we were curious about the application forms and the French Fund loan plan to which you made reference in some of your correspondence. You will note from statistical reports that the number of eugenical sterilizations in this County have increased materially in recent months. In addition, there are numerous cases referred to doctors for sterilization on a therapeutic basis. These cases are not reported.

We have found your publication "Sterilization — Questions and Answers" to be very helpful. You will, no doubt, be interested in the attached statement which we have prepared for the purpose of educating our own staff. We will be wanting additional copies of your "Questions and Answers" publication, and will send a check at the appropriate time to cover the cost.
